TERMS & CONDITIONS:-

1. The re auction of Maruti Gypsy and Toyota Qualis and Motor Cycles (Bullet) shall be held under the supervision of the Committee consisting of Sub Divisional Police, Diu, Deputy Collector, Diu, Assistant Accounts Officer, Diu & Assistant Engineer, P.W.D., S.D. I, Diu on 15/05/2015 at 10.00 A.M.
2. The re auction shall be held on bid system, interested bidder shall have to deposit a token amount of Rs.1000/- at the time of re auction for taking part in it. The said amount be refunded back to the unsuccessful bidder after the re auction. The successful bidder has to deposit 10% of the offered bid on the spot.
3. The bid should be offered a maximum Rs. 500/- above on the upset price.
4. An offer shall be considered as highest and final only if the amount of bid offered by the bidder is announced consequently three times uninterrupted.
5. The successful bidder shall have to lift the re auctioned vehicles and motor cycle within three days from the date of finalization of the re auction after which this office shall not be responsible for their safe custody.
