
The quarries raised are clarified as under:-

(A) Quarries Revised by Bidders present.		
1	Performance security: Validity is asked for till end of O&M phase. Since O&M is a part of overall contract, it is requested that the Performance security be released after the construction phase is over and a fresh performance security of 5% of the contract amount be allowed in lieu of the 10%. Clause 33.1	It is As per the approved NIT/ tender documents by Competent authority.
2	Retention Money: Similarly please reply what will be the date of the taking over.	It is As per the approved NIT/ tender documents by Competent authority.
3	MOU for the Landfill Geo membrane and Geo synthetic material should not be asked as we will decide later which manufacturer we will go ahead with. Having a MOU will restrict us to that manufacturer and the cost may increase if the tender is awarded to us since we may not be in a good negotiating position then because of our agreement.	It is As per the approved NIT/ tender documents by Competent authority.



5	Relaxation in clause 4.4 for the O&M to include equipment supplies is requested as this tender comprises of mainly infrastructure works and O&M is a subsequent work.	It is As per the approved NIT/ tender documents by Competent authority.
6	Clause no. 7.3 mentions about picture of site visits. Is it important to include them in the bid documents.	It is important to visit site. They may submit picture.
7	Clause no. 15.1 we request bid security in the form of BG also.	No change
8	Clause no. 40.1: As per this clause the guarantee on the plan will be 6 years i.e. 5 years O&M plus one more year after trial run period. This should be reduced to one year only from the date of trial run.	No change
9	Clause no. 3.2.2 page 106, we should be given the option to install a trouble free compost plant rather than restricting us to someone else's specification.	It is a turnkey base contract work. To be carried out as per tender documents.
10	Please inform the capacity of the underground water reservoir, Clause 5.9 page 115	U. G. W. reservoir capacity 50,000 liters
11	Please inform the size of the security house, clause 5.7 page 114	It is as per BOQ sheet of tender documents.
12	What will be the waste quantity expected to be received in the facility to calculate the O&M coasts, clause 9.14. You have mentioned that the compost plant capacity is 50 TPD and we will have the suitable manpower to manage the waste. What is the amount payable to us is the waste volumes increase beyond 50 TPD.	The project is framed based on the expected waste quantity which required 50 TPD capacity compost plant. The plant design is for ultimate design input of 20 years.
13	Who will be the owner of the ready compost and the recyclables after processing?	
14	If the project also basis the compost sale then it is impossible to calculate the cost ref page no 102 point no. 3.1.4 where it clearly says that 50TPD plant will remain underutilized. So how can we calculate the compost output.	The plant design is for ultimate design input of 20 years.
15	Is the final compost to be packed in bags or kept loose. If bags then who will bear the cost of bags.	
16	There is no need to operate plant in 3 shifts as the waste quantity is only 50TPD. This small quantity can be easily processed in a single shift. Plants that are more than 600 TPD operate on double shifts. Therefore the requirement of manpower will also reduce accordingly.	It is as per schedule of operation determined on requirement.

18	Who will pay for the consumables required in the landfill.	It is the responsibility of the bidder.
19	What will be the payment terms for civil works and procurement of equipment for development of landfill and compost plant.	As per the tender documents.
20	What will be the payment terms for the O&M part.	The tender is turnkey contract for establishment of compost plant & landfill site including the O&M for 5 years. The product after waste processing will have to be taken by the bidder. No any payment of O&M part will be paid.
21	Estimated cost is too low for the overall work involving O&M. Do you have the budget for this project or not?	It is as per approved NIT/ tender documents by Competent authority.
22	Who will provide the vehicles inside the compost plant like tractor trolleys, lorry, front end loader etc., road roller for landfill page 102.	It is the bidder responsibility and as per tender documents.
23	Is there a requirement of a boundary wall?	Boundary wall is not included except provided in NIT/Tender documents.


