ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE

WHEREAS, a large number of tourist who are visiting Diu District, including Foreigners, from nearby Gujarat State as well as local people are venturing into the Sea at Nagoa Beach to swim and have bath;

AND WHEREAS, it is has been reported that tourists who come for Holiday, sight seeing especially at Nagoa Beach venture into the Sea to have a jolly swim and bath in which due to monsoon season the Sea is rough and due to strong current the tourists drown and there is loss of human life;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers under Section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973,(No.2 of 1974) I, **P. S. Jani, District Magistrate, Diu** hereby order that No tourists, including foreigner, from nearby state of Gujarat as well as local people be allowed to venture in Sea to swim or have bath at all the beaches of Diu District especially Nagoa beach from where incident of drowning has been reported to prevent danger to the human life.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect from 30/06/2017 upto 28/08/2017 and shall be effective for a period of 60 days(both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
