ORDER


(Under Section 34 and 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005)

In continuation of Order No. No.COL/Diu/DIS/DM-2005/2019-20/2036 dated 20/03/2020, whereincertain restrictions were placed for contain the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) in Diu District.

In view of the emerging situation in the country and considering the importance of preventing the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) it has been decided to place further restrictions in Diu District.

Therefore, **I, Harminder Singh, I/c District Magistrate, Diu**, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 34 and 51 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby order as follows:-

- 1) All the Bar, Restuarants and road side eateries shall be closed with immediate effect till 31/03/2020.
- 2) All the retail shops, selling non-essential items, shall be closed down with immediate effect till 31st March,2020.
- 3) All Owners of Hotels, Resorts, paying Guest House etc shall not received any new bookings till 31st March,2020 and the existing bookings shall be cancelled if possible.
- 4) All the public places such as Beaches, Gardens, Churches, Museum, Fort and tourist spots shall be closed with immediate effect till 31st March,2020.
- 5) All the Owners of Retailers and Traders shall not hoard any essential food items and medical supplies and no excessive prices should be charge/levied on any commodities.
- 6) Entry in Diu district from all check points shall be restricted to the bonafide residents or vichles operating for providing essential goods or services in Diu District. All other non-essential travelling vehicles/passenger shall not be allowed to enter in Diu with immediate effect.
- 7) The frequency of the Sarathi and Parivahan Bus services should be reduced to 50% of the existing trips and a dedicated bus service shall be made available from Ghoghla check post to Jethibai Bus Stand, Diu in every half an hour. Motor Vehicle Inspector, Diu/Manager(Transport),OIDC to ensure the compliance.

Public at large is also informed that Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act,2005 provides for penalties in case a person obstructs any officer of employee in discharge of his functions or refuses to comply with any direction given under this Act. Any violation of the above directions will, therefore, lead to prosecution under section 51 of the Disaster Management Act,2005.
