TENDER NOTICE

The Superintendent, Transport Department, Collectorate, Diu intends to dispose of the following condemned Staff Cars on "as-is-where-is-basis".

2. Accordingly, sealed quotations are invited for the disposal of the aforesaid condemned vehicle on the terms and conditions mentioned below. The intending purchasers are requested to send their quotation in the enclosed proforma addressed to the Superintendent, Transport Department, Collectorate, Diu-362520, in a sealed cover **latest by 12.00 PM on 04-06-2021**. The quotations should be dropped in the tender Box kept at Dispatch Counter or reach the undersigned by the time mentioned above. The cover should be prominently superscribed as "**QUOTATIONS FOR PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE**". The Vehicle will be available for inspection **26-05-2021 to 02-06-2021** after contacting the Accounts Section, Collectorate, Diu.

3. The quotations received in time will be opened at **3.30 PM on 04-06-2021** in Chamber of the undersigned. The tenderers or their representative (not more than one) may be present, if they so desire at the time of opening of quotations.

4. The sale will be governed by the following terms and conditions:

- (i) The tenderer is required to pay EMD of Rs. 5000/-.
- (ii) EMD is payable in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank in favour of Superintendent, Collectorate, Diu. Quotations received without EMD will not be considered and shall not be accepted. The EMD will be returned to unsuccessful tenderers at the earliest. The EMD will be returned to successful tenderer, after getting the payment in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Superintendent, Collectorate, Diu from the tenderer and finalization of sale.
- (iii) Payment in full will have to be made by the successful tenderer in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank in favour of Superintendent, Collectorate, Diu or through POS machine before taking delivery of the condemned Staff Car within two working days from the date of acceptance of the offer.
- (iv) The delivery of the auctioned Staff Cars will be arranged only after the successful tenderer submits documentary evidence in support of residential status (Aadhaar Card / Voter Identity Card / Passport / Driving License or any other valid proof of address in case of individual and registration Certificate in case of firms etc.).

- (v) The Successful tenderer must remove auctioned Staff Cars within two working days from the date of acceptance of the offer by Govt. failing which penalty of Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per day will have to be paid. If these Staff Cars are not removed within ten days from the date of auction, the EMD will be forfeited by the Govt. and he / she will have no claims over the vehicle(s), whatsoever.
- (vi) The successful tenderer will make his / her own arrangement for transport and he will not be entitled to claim any facilities or assistance for removal from the Government.
- (vii) The condemned staff Cars will be sold strictly on "as is where is basis". These Staff Cars are sold on the assumption that tenderer have inspected them which are being sold by this department and they know what they are buying, whether they have first inspected them or not. No complaint will be entertained after the sale.
- (viii) If the Government feels that the highest rates offered by the tenderer is not reasonable, the sale of the condemned Staff Cars by calling quotations for the same will be treated as cancelled and the tenderer will have no right to take this case in any court of India because such cancellation of sale of condemned Staff Car will be done at the discretion and in the interest of Government of India,
- (ix) If the tenderer resiles or fails to observe / comply with any of the above stipulations, the EMD shall be forfeited by the Government.
- (x) This Department reserves the right to accept or reject any / all quotations without assigning any reason.
